

# **SOCCER ALL-STAR MATCH**

## **Effective 2019 - 2020**

The boys' and girls' All-Star matches will be played on Sunday, November 10, 2019, at St. Clairsville High School.

Girls will play at 1:00PM.

Boys will play at 3:30PM.

Voting for the All-Star Match will be done on line.

Each coach may nominate **UP TO FIVE (5)** players for consideration. Nominations **MUST BE SENIORS. WHEN NOMINATING PLAYERS, COACHES MUST CLEARLY PRIORITIZE THEIR CHOICES [Example: Mary Jones (3)] as the computer will arrange them in alphabetical order, not your order of preference.**

Girls who play on coed teams will be nominated for the girls' match.

For 2019, the head coach will be from Class 1A-3A, with assistants coming from 4A and 5A. Once the coaches have been selected (according to their standings after the championship), they are expected to communicate with each other in selecting their team.

Each school shall place one (1) player on the team. Remaining spots will be determined by the coaching staff.

Each team shall consist of twenty-two (22) players for the game. **NO SCHOOL MAY HAVE MORE THAN THREE PLAYERS.** Once the twenty-two players have been selected, there will be no replacements for those who decline playing.

Any senior selected as Player-of-the-Year **MUST** be in the All-Star Match.

### **COACHING ROTATION**

Coaches for the game shall be selected from the class championship teams.

Should a coach decline, it will move to the class runner-up. From there, it will be determined by the final standings (3rd, 4th, etc.)

For 2019, the head coach will be from Class 1A-3A, with assistants coming from 4A and 5A.

For 2020, the head coach will be from Class 4A, with assistants coming from 1A-3A and 5A.

For 2021, the head coach will be from Class 5A, with assistants coming from 1A-3A and 4A.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Teams are eligible to participate in OVAC playoffs as prescribed by the respective sport by scheduling at least eight games against OVAC opponents or playing at least six against OVAC opponents. In the event that a team schedules fewer than eight games against OVAC opponents, a minimum of six games must be played against OVAC opponents; if eight or more are scheduled against OVAC opponents, a minimum of four must be played. All Conference games scheduled and played must be done prior to the cutoff date listed for that sport.

**Schools who do not play the required matches prior to the cutoff date to be eligible for the championship and who fail to leave the dates open to participate in the championship (or choose not to play in the final four) will not be eligible to have players in the All-Star match, have All-Conference selections, or be eligible for any sport specific scholarships.**

**Additionally, a \$60 penalty will be added to their dues for the following year.**
