**SELECTION MEETING:** Selection for the All-Star game will be done electronically this year. Coaches will receive nomination ballots and forms through the OVAC website, [www.ovac.org](http://www.ovac.org). It is imperative that every coach has an e-mail address and password to log onto the website.

The following schedule will be followed for **GIRLS:**  
**Saturday, January 30, 2021:** Nomination forms sent to coaches

**Wednesday, February 3, 2021:** Nominations form due

**Friday, February 5, 2021:** Voting for all-stars begins

**Tuesday, February 9, 2021:** All-star voting ends.

The following schedule will be followed for **BOYS:**  
**Saturday, February 6, 2021:** Nomination forms sent to coaches

**Wednesday, February 10, 2021:** Nominations form due

**Friday, February 12, 2021:** Voting for all-stars begins

**Tuesday, February 16, 2021:** All-star voting ends.

1. There will be one (1) boys' game and one (1) girls' game.

2. Each team will consist of fifteen (15) players as voted upon by the varsity head coaches.

3. Each school may nominate up to three (3) senior players. Consideration should be given to the fact that the more players nominated, the more it will split the votes. **Players should be of true all-star caliber.**

4. **VOTING/SELECTION:** Once the nominations are in, coaches will receive a ballot listing all players by state. They will be asked to vote for the best fifteen (15) players from their state. This will produce a list of results from the most to the least votes.

From this list, one (1) player will be selected from each class in Ohio. In West Virginia, one (1) player will be selected from 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, and 5A.

Once these players are determined to insure that each class is represented, the next ten (Ohio) or eleven (West Virginia) players will be placed on the team.

5. The next five (5) highest vote getters in the voting will comprise an alternate pool. In the event that one of the fifteen players does not play in the game, the director will select a player from the pool to fill the vacancy.

6. When coaches submit their nominations, they will be asked to vote for one (1) coach from their state who they feel deserves the honor of coaching in the game. These coaches will be contacted as to their availability and placed on a ballot. The highest vote getter will be the head coach, with the second and third place vote getters becoming assistants.
